(The Angel Gabriel Announces to the Virgin Mary that she will bear the Son of the Most High)

6. *Luke 1:57-80* (John the Baptist is born and his father rejoices that his son will prepare the way of the Lord)

Hymn #99 “Go Tell it on the Mountain”

7. *Luke 2:1-20*

(Jesus is born in Bethlehem and is worshipped by angels and shepherds)

Hymn #105 (vs 1,4) "God Rest Ye Merry Gentlemen"

8. *Luke 2:21-35*

(Jesus receives his name
and is presented to Simeon in
the temple)

Hymn #101 “Away in a Manger”

9. (The Word was made flesh and we have seen His glory)

Hymn #93 vs 1,2 “Angels from the Realms of Glory”
